Terms and conditions - Worm Farm Rebate

1. Applicants must attend a *Reducing your Food Waste with Worm Farms* Workshop facilitated by the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder before applying for the rebate. Eligible workshops are listed on the City of City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder Website.
2. Photo ID must be sighted at the *Reducing your Food Waste with Worm Farms* Workshop to ensure you are a resident of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder.
3. An application must be lodged within 6 months of attending a *Reducing your Food Waste with Worm Farms* Workshop.
4. Applicants may receive a rebate up to the value of \$50 only.
5. The Worm Farm Rebate is a one-off payment per household.
6. The applicant must reside within the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder and provide proof of residence to receive the rebate. Accepted proof of residence includes a driver's licence, or a lease agreement, rates notice, or utility bill dated within 3 months of the application submission.
7. Only worm farms, worm cafes and similar vermicompost units are eligible.
8. This rebate does not include any transport, postage costs or accessories.
9. The applicant must provide a copy of a receipt evidencing the purchase of the worm farm unit, including -
 - a) the company name where compost unit was purchased
 - b) the date of payment (within 6 months of workshop attendance)
 - c) item name (clearly indicating which worm farm was purchased)
 - d) the cost of worm farm purchase
10. Applications will be assessed to determine whether the applicant is eligible for a rebate. Applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application within 30 days of submitting an application.
11. Payment will be made via EFT to the bank account nominated by the applicant approximately 4 to 6 weeks from notification that the application has been successful. Cash or cheque payments cannot be issued.
12. The City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder holds no responsibility for following up incomplete, invalid applications and reserves the right to reject any application that does not comply to these terms and conditions.
13. Worm farm rebate is subject to annual funding availability and while stocks last. If the rebate is no longer available when you apply, you will be contacted upon receipt of your application and added to a waiting list for the next available funding.
