Rubbish Collection Service

Council on behalf of the ratepayers of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder, and in accordance with the Health Act 1911, contract the domestic waste collection service to Transpacific Cleanaway, for the removal and disposal of all household and commercial rubbish to the Yarri Road Waste Facility.

Council determines annually, and identifies in your rates each year, an amount for refuse removal. The rate charged covers the pick up of one 240 litre bin once per week.

You may have more than one bin, however the rate charged increases by the number of bins that are to be serviced.

On completion of a Bin Request Form, the City will notify the contractor, who will deliver a suitable bin to your property.

The bin is then emptied according to the type of service and frequency you have selected.

The weight of the bin should not exceed 70 kilograms.

Correct bin placement and weight is essential in order to ensure that the contractor can provide the best possible service.

Do's

- Place bin in the correct position as shown on attached diagram.
- Place bin at the edge of the kerb, in front of your property with the handle facing towards property.
- Place bin out by 6am on the morning of collection.

Don'ts

- Overload bin.
- Face bin in the wrong direction.
- Do not place the following materials inside your bin;
 - Flammable liquids
 - Hot ashes
 - Tyres
 - Syringes/needles
 - Rubble
 - Steel
 - Timber pieces (all types of building products)
 - Hazardous materials
