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DOG OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The Dog Act 1976 and the City's Dog Local Law state dog owners must ensure: Their dog(s) must wear a collar disaplaying the owner's name, address and

council registration tag when in a public place.

- All dogs aged over three months must be registered and penalties apply for failing to register your dog(s).
- It is under the control of a person capable of controlling the dog when on a lead (cannot exceed two metres in length) when in a public space.
- When exercised off leash in designated areas, the person in control must carry a leash to ensure the dog can be restrained if required.
- Dog(s) are effectively confined with the owners property when not on a lead or in a dog exercise area.
- That the property that the dog(s) are registered to must be capable of

effectively confining the dog(s) by means of a fence or similar.

That no more than two dogs over the age of three months are kept on the property without an exemption from the city.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- · Dog registration must be renewed prior to the 1st November of the year of expiry.
- The City must be informed immediately of any change of details (i.e. deceased, ownership, address etc.)
- Reduced registration fees apply upon proof of a current.
