

FACT SHEET

Commercial Green Waste Disposal

From the 1st of July 2021 uncontaminated green waste disposed by commercial customers at the Yarri Road Refuse Facility will attract a fee as outlined in the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder Fees and Charges.

Please note the following guidelines apply to uncontaminated green waste disposal:

Uncontaminated Green Waste consists of:

- · Garden prunings, weeds and leaves;
- Palm leaves:
- Tree loppings (less than 1.5m in length); and
- Tree limbs, branches, small logs (1.5m in length).

Note: Branches more than 150mm in diameter must be cut into 300mm lengths or smaller.

Loads containing the following items are not considered Uncontaminated Green Waste and will be charged as mixed general waste:

- Mixed loads including general waste, building products, sands soils and gravels;
- Tree stumps;
- Bagged green waste; and
- Contaminated green waste (i.e. rubbish present in green waste)

Note: Treated timber/pine pallets are charged separately/per item.




Figure 3: Logs with a diameter greater than 150mm must be cut into lengths that are less than 300mm.
