# LOCAL HERITAGE FUND

### What is the Local Heritage Fund?

If you own a building that is listed on the Local Government Inventory of Heritage Places, you may be eligible for funding under this scheme. Dollar-for-dollar funding up to a specified amount is available for both conservation work and the development of a Conservation Management Strategy.

### What's changed?

The new Local Heritage Fund was adopted by Council on 27 March 2017. The changes include:

- Applications will only be received once per year. This year, the City invites applications from 29 July 2019, with the last day to submit on 27 September 2019.
- A tiered system of funding for Conservation Management Strategies
- Streamlined funding amounts to allow the City to co-fund more projects
- A minimum of two quotes required for all proposed conservation work • Acquittal of funding will occur following inspection of the completed conservation work. Work will need to be completed to the satisfaction of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder.

### How do I apply?

To apply, please complete an application form and lodge with the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder. Prior to doing so, it is recommended you contact the City's Heritage Advisor to discuss your proposal.
